## 3359-02-03 University libraries administration.

- (A) Dean of university libraries.
  - (1) The dean of university libraries shall be appointed by the board upon recommendation of the president; shall be responsible to the president through the senior vice president and provost. The dean shall hold office at the discretion of the senior vice president and provost.
  - (2) Among the dean's duties shall be to: act as administrative head of the university libraries and be charged with the general supervision thereof; recommend the allocation of available funds for the university libraries use among the colleges and departments; recommend to the senior vice president and provost appointments to, and dismissals from the staff; purchase, classify, catalog, and prepare for circulation all books and periodicals; take reasonable precautions for the preservation and safe-guarding of all books, documents, equipment, and other property; submit to the president an annual report concerning the activities, conditions, and needs of the university libraries and notify the senior vice president and provost of budgetary needs; prepare, in consultation with university libraries faculty and staff, an annual strategic planning update; and offer students and faculty such formal and informal aids in the use of the university libraries as occasion demands.
- (B) Librarian of the school of law.

The librarian of the school of law shall be appointed by the board upon recommendation of the president; shall be responsible to the president through the dean of the school of law and the senior vice president and provost; shall hold office at the discretion of the president; shall administer the school of law library in accordance with good practice; and shall utilize the access services division of the university libraries to assist in the operation of the school of law library.
