3359-60-033 Repeating courses.

Any course may be repeated as many times as necessary twice by an undergraduate student subject to the following conditions:

- (A) In order to secure a grade ("A" "F") or a grade of "NC," "CR" or "AUD," a student may repeat a course in which the previously received grade was "C-," "D+," "D," "D-," "F," "AUD" or "NC." Registrations under the "CR/NC" option are subject to the restrictions in the "CR/NC" policy.
 - (B) The student must repeat the same course within twelve months of the completion of the prior attempt. With the dean's permission, a student may extend this period or substitute another course if the previous course is no longer offered. Courses must be repeated at the university of Akron.
- (C) To secure a grade ("A-F") or a grade of "NC", "CR" or "AUD", a student may repeat a course in which the previously received grade was "C-", "D + ", "D", "D-", "F", "AUD" or "NC". Registration under the "CR/NC" option is subject to the restrictions in the "CR./NC" policy a student may repeat a course in which the previously received grade was a "C-," "D+," "D," "D-," or "F," "CR," "NC," or "AUD." Registrations under the "CR/NC" option are subject to the restrictions in the "CR/NC" policy.
- (B) To secure a "CR," a student may repeat a course in which the previously received grade was a "NC." Registrations under the "CR/NC" option are subject to the restrictions in the "CR/NC" policy.
- (C) To secure a grade ("A-F"), "CR," "NC," a student may repeat a course in which the previously received grade was an "AUD." Registrations under the "CR/NC" option are subject to the restrictions in the "CR/NC" policy.
- (D) A graded course ("A-F") may not be repeated for a grade of "AUD."
- (E) A course taken under the "CR/NC" option may not be repeated for a grade of <u>"AUD."</u>
- (F) With the dean's permission, a student may substitute another course if the previous course is no longer offered. Courses must be repeated at the university of <u>Akron.</u>
- (C)(G) Grades for all attempts at a course will appear on the student's official academic record.
- (D)(H) Only the grade for the last attempt will be used in the grade-point average.

- (E)(I) All grades for attempts at a course will be used in grade-point calculation for the purpose of determining graduation with honors and class standing.
- (F)(J) For purposes of this rule, credit for a course or its equivalent will apply only once toward meeting degree requirements.
