Assist with the maintenance and upkeep of Wayne Campus buildings and grounds. Set up and tear down settings for the special events held on campus.

Essential Functions:

65% Clean classrooms and offices. Mop, waxe, buff,or scrub floors and carpets. Wipe down chalkboards and empty trash receptacles.

20% Perform outside maintenance by mowing grass, trimming shrubs, weeding and fertilizing the lawn. Remove snow and ice and spread salt on the sidewalks during the winter seasons.

10% Set up and tear down special settings for functions held at the college.

5% Direct the work of student helpers assigned.

Education:

Requires high school diploma or GED.

Experience:
