 - As of last week, Diane Raybuck informed the group that enrollment projections for Fall
 2013 are down 3%, not 7% that many people believed
 - Adult and Transfer students are target groups
 - o International students Holly Harris-Bane working on this initiative
 - Kent State University is at capacity for entering freshman students as reported in the press
 - UA has not seen any significant bump in enrollment because of this
 - UA has seen students from OSU and private institutions
- Discussion about possibility of employee layoffs
 - o Current number of Contract Professionals is 576
